

Sullivan County Farm Bureau New Hampshire Scholarship Award

Sullivan County Farm Bureau is a non-profit county organization of the New Hampshire Farm Bureau Federation. The Sullivan County Farm Bureau will award up to two scholarships per year, each in the amount of \$500. The scholarships are awarded only to current SCFB members and /or the children of parents/guardians who are Sullivan County Farm Bureau members and who are up to date on dues. If the parents or guardians of the applicant are not currently members of the Sullivan County Farm Bureau, please visit the following website to join and for more information about the Farm Bureau Federation: <https://nhfarmbureau.org/>

Deadline for submission of applications is May 10, 2016. All applications will be reviewed by a committee of the Sullivan County Farm Bureau and those awarded scholarships will be informed by mail. Preference will be awarded to applicants pursuing any agriculture related study, though all applications are welcome.

With the completed application, please include two letters of recommendation. One recommendation must be from a teacher, advisor, administrator, tutor or other personnel from the education field. The other recommendation is general, but must be from a non-family member.

If applicant is a returning college student, in place of the letters of recommendation, you will need to send a copy of your transcript (it can be your unofficial transcript) along with the completed application.

This Scholarship is available to all students, youth or adult, attending post-secondary or continuing education or participating in an agriculture-related project. Anyone can apply even if he/she has been the recipient of this scholarship award in the past.

Scholarship awards will be announced by June 1. Scholarship funds will be sent directly to the permanent address of the scholarship recipient upon his or her entry into the second semester of education.

Completed applications and recommendations must be received by mail or email on or before May 10, 2016.
